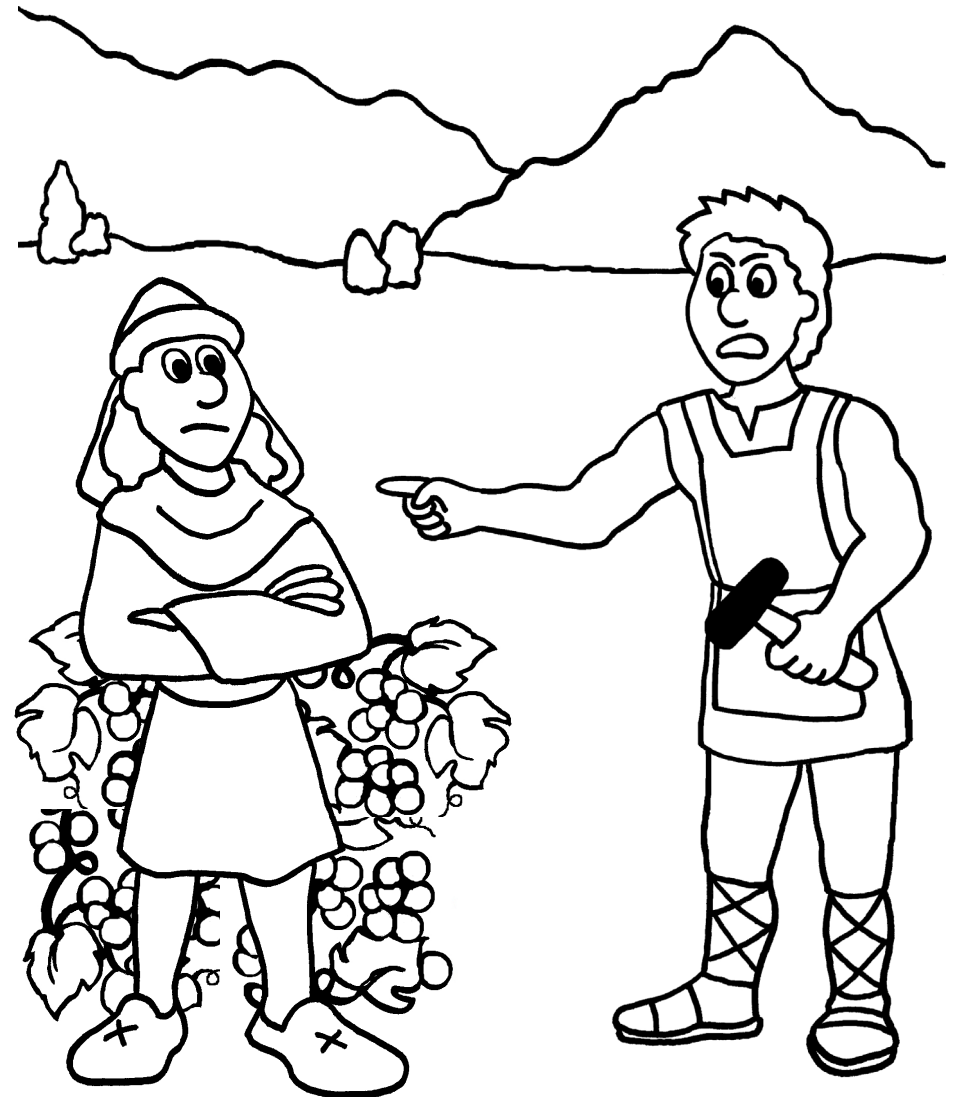

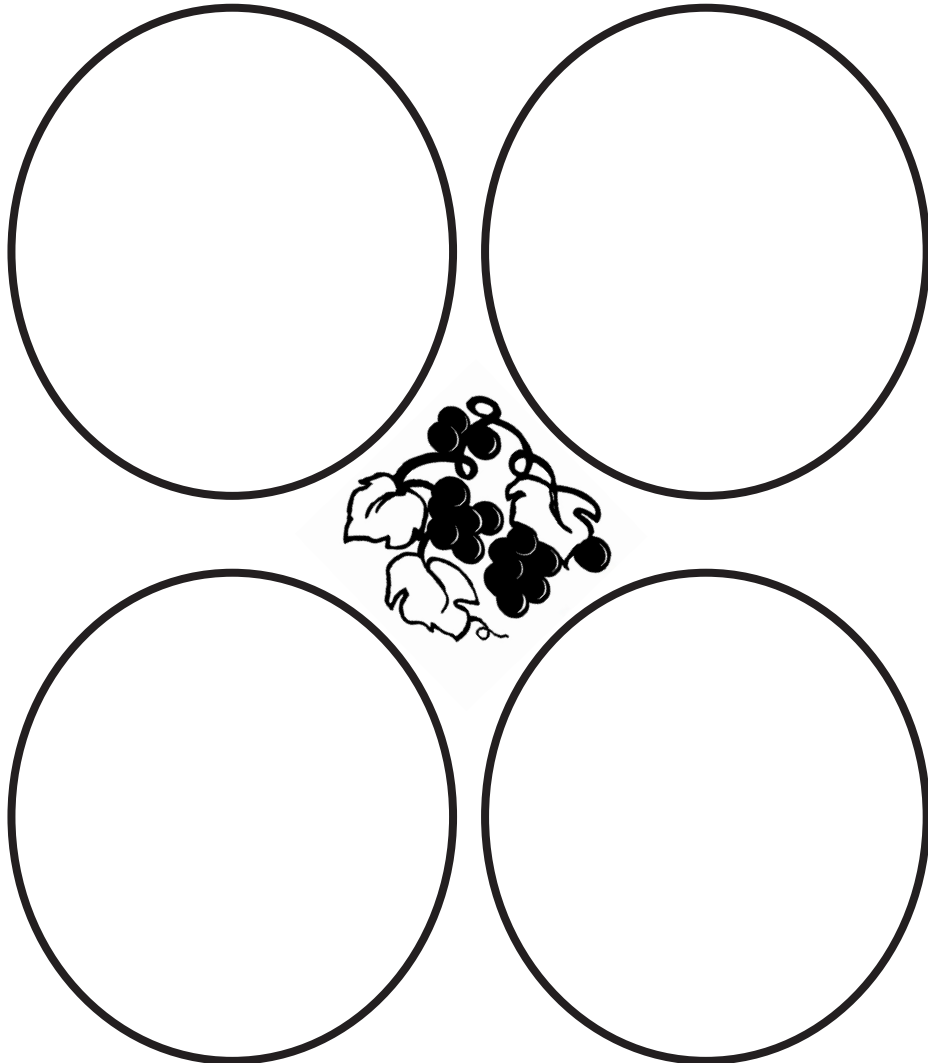

*Write the new words on the lines, and in the empty spaces at the bottom of the page!*

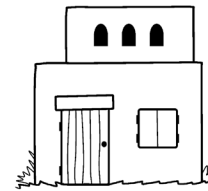
